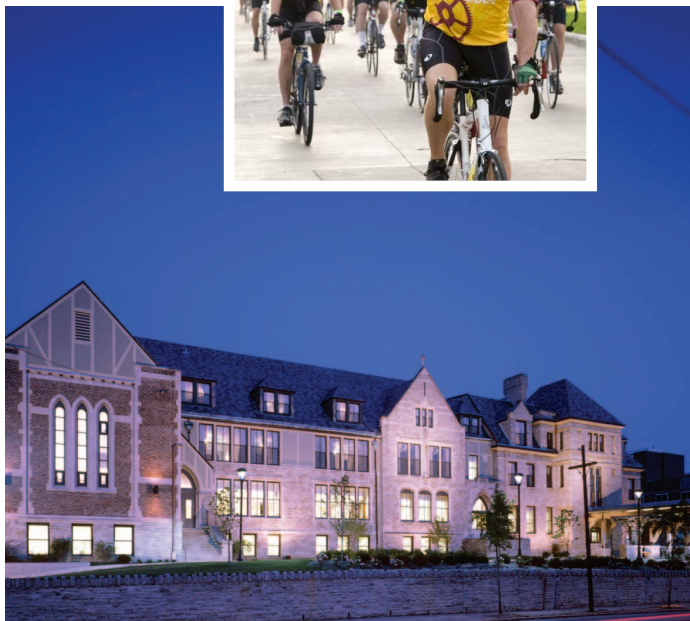

## The American Cancer Society's **Pan Ohio Hope Ride**

July 29 - August 1, 2010

[328 miles Cleveland to Cincinnati]

### **What is the Pan Ohio Hope Ride?**

The Pan Ohio Hope Ride is the American Cancer Society's unique event to raise money and save lives by helping you stay well, helping you get well, by finding cures and by fighting back. One way your donations helps cancer patients get well is by supporting Hope Lodges. In 2009, the Pan Ohio Hope Ride raised over \$250,000. This year our goal is to double that with \$500,000.

The Pan Ohio Hope Ride is a noncompetitive, four-day, multistage cycling event starting at the Society's Hope Lodge in Cleveland and ending at the Hope Lodge in Cincinnati. This year's ride is expected to include 500 riders and an army of dedicated volunteers.

### **What is a Hope Lodge?**

Getting the right care sometimes means cancer patients must travel far from home for treatment. This places even more of an emotional and financial burden on cancer patients and their families.

The Society's Hope Lodges offer free, supportive housing for patients undergoing treatment. Hope Lodges are more than just a place to stay. They provide a home-like, nurturing environment so patients can get support from others going through the same experience.
